What do we do?

Our Concussion Care package takes the advances learnt in elite sport and makes them available to schools and clubs. The package includes:

Telemedicine Concussion Management

- Access to clinics run 7 days-a-week. Our doctors are made up of the UK's leading concussion experts who also work in elite sport at Saracens, Harlequins, London Irish and more.

Frequently Asked Questions

These are some commonly asked questions from schools and clubs:

Q. Why do you use telemedicine? Is that as good as inperson appointments?

A. It is widely published in medical literature that the outcomes from telemedicine appointments are the same as in-person for concussion assessments. Using telemedicine means that players can have access to the UK's leading concussion experts at convenient times which they otherwise wouldn't be able to do.

Q. Is there flexibility on cost or payment terms?

A. We are always happy to discuss pricing or introduce payment terms. We do not want finances to prevent us providing care to your players.

Q. How quickly can we launch? Should we wait until next September now?

A. We can launch immediately. If needed, we can discuss payment terms to help with an immediate launch.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Can we use this for our rugby teams only?

A. We strongly encourage you to not view this as a "rugby issue". Concussions happen in all sports and non-sport. Behind rugby, the second highest incidence rate is "non-sporting" such as playground injuries.

Q. Is this going to mean more admin for our staff? We already have lots of systems in place.

A. Recording an injury on the R2P System can mean double data-entry in some cases. This is no different to when nurses refer to specialists as they will already do for other injuries.

Q. Can we use the R2P System for all injuries?

A. Yes. All injuries can be recorded, but only concussions will be linked to our doctors.

Q. Does this cover players over school holidays or trips?

A. Yes, the cover is for 365 days of the year and whether the injury happens inside or outside of school.
